## WHAT IS IT?

Our Smoke-Free Palmetto State certification recognizes your town, city, or county's achievement in adopting and implementing a comprehensive smoke-free law covering all indoor workplaces, restaurants, and bars.

## WHAT DOES IT DO?

Certification will allow local governments to better advertise that they've made significant steps in improving the health and economic well-being of their community. This includes a web badge, window decals, and a shout out on our website and social media.



# HOW TO GET IT

## REQUIREMENTS

To meet our certification standards, a community's law must prohibit smoking in all indoor workplaces, restaurants and bars. SCTFC also provides hands-on technical assistance during the policy adoption and implementation stages.

## REVIEW PROCESS

To obtain certification, local governments should submit proposed, pending or existing policies to SCTFC for evaluation. If the policy meets requirements, SCTFC will get in touch to help you receive the benefits of your Smoke-Free Palmetto State certification.
