Am I fully protected after the vaccine?

Not quite. No vaccine is 100% effective, but the approved vaccines are showing very high effective rate. This means that if you get the vaccine, it greatly reduces your chance of getting sick, hospitalization and death. Wearing masks and washing your hands are still needed to protect all.
