FDA SAFETY WARNINGS ARE EVIDENCE OF OUR SYSTEMS WORKING.

You may have heard about an FDA warning about a very rare risk of Guillain-Barre syndrome attached to two RSV vaccines, Abrysvo and Arexvy. This warning might sound scary, but it's a sign that our strict vaccine monitoring systems **are working**.

Once vaccines are available to the public, researchers continuously monitor even the rarest side effects to ensure their safety.

The FDA communicates these rare events so that individuals can make informed decisions about their personal health and immunizations.

There's an increased risk of some individuals developing Guillain-Barre syndrome in rare cases. But it does **not** mean the vaccines cause it in every individual.

THE BOTTOM LINE:

The benefits of RSV vaccines **greatly outweigh the rare risks**. Older adults and pregnant people should still get vaccinated.



Vaccine monitoring systems will continue to make sure that RSV vaccines, and all others, are safe.
