What is the Vaccine Resource Hub?

The Vaccine Resource Hub (VRH) is a trusted collection of free, culturally relevant, science-based materials that support vaccine communications and outreach. It is part of the Health Communications Initiative, which helps make accurate health information easy to find, share, and use.

Why submit your content?

Sharing your materials with the VRH helps you:

- Reach trusted community-based organizations that may not already be aware of your content—extending your impact to new audiences and local networks.
- Increase credibility by featuring your materials on a trusted national platform curated for cultural relevance and scientific accuracy.
- Amplify your efforts by making it easier for others to discover, adapt, and use your content in the communities they serve.

What type of content can be submitted?

All resources on the VRH show attribution to the organization that created them. Most are unbranded, so others can use and adapt them freely without needing to include that attribution in their own materials. We welcome public-facing, evidence-based resources, including:

- Fact sheets and flyers
- Infographics
- Short videos

- Social media graphics and posts
- Toolkits and guides

How does it work?

Submitting is simple:

- 1. Confirm your materials are publicfacing and accurate.
- 2. Send them via the online submission form.
- 3. The VRH team reviews, tags, and posts them so others can find and use them.
